As children get older, the protection from infant immunizations can wear off. Children can also be at risk of new diseases as they enter their pre-teen and teen years. Additional vaccines are required to keep your child healthy.

Horizon Public Health will be offering vaccinations to all Grade 7 students as part of the routine school immunization program.

- For students in **Grade 7**, we will be offering protection against [human papillomavirus \(HPV\)](#) and [tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis](#).
