Dear Parent/Guardian:

As children grow older, the protection from early childhood immunizations can decrease. Children can also be at risk of new diseases as they enter their pre-teen and teen years.

Horizon Public Health will be offering vaccinations to all Grade 7 and Grade 9 students as part of the routine school-based immunization program.

Vaccines Offered

For Grade 7 students, vaccines will be offered to protect against:

- [Human papillomavirus \(HPV\)](#)
- [Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis \(Tdap\)](#)

For Grade 9 students, vaccines will be offered to protect against:

- [Meningococcal-C-ACYM \(Meningitis\)](#)
